AQUINAS FC IN THE COMMUNITY



COACH EDUCATION

Aquinas FC have aspirations to have some of the best coaches available for youth football. To do that we need to provide the appropriate training and mentoring.

Earlier in the season the club put 20 people through IFA grassroots program.

During the summer of 2020 we hope to have a number of people take their coach education further with UEFA B Licence Part 1 and others finish Part 2. This is an intensive 7 day (9am to 9pm) course which is a big commitment for the coach, but something which should benefit everyone in long run.
